Monica is also a volunteer and holds the position of Secretary of the Board of the Rhoda Wise Shrine, in Canton, OH.

Monica says, "I am humbled, thrilled and in awe of how our Lord has brought Fidelis to me. I am excited to work with the staff and all of the incredible women involved in this community to help women lead virtuous lives and grow closer to Christ."

# What was it about Fidelis' mission that made you want to contribute?
